# MARC ANTHONY TO PERFORM "LIVE!" AT THE ALTOS DE CHAVÓN AMPHITHEATER ON MARCH 26TH

After Breaking Record Sales at Madison Square Garden in New York, the Idol is Returning to the Dominican Republic
