And to finish the weekend, a very special brunch will be held at Pubbelly Sushi on Sunday the 17th, where the same brunch offered in the renowned Pubbelly Miami restaurant will be recreated.

Flavors of the World consists of a series of monthly gastronomic events, dedicated to a different country on every occasion, culminating with a grand festival at the end of the year. The event has had the participation and collaboration of Moment Designers, Pubbelly Sushi, Sunix, Tropigas, Chivas, BrugalXV, Listin Diario, Ritmo Social, Vinos S.A., and Orange.
