



David Guetta Will Spin at the Iconic Altos de Chavón Amphitheater on December 30

He will be performing on the night of December 30 at Altos de Chavón Amphitheater as part of a New Year's Eve celebration that has been going on since 2015, in which artists as important as Juan Luis Guerra and Enrique Iglesias have graced the stage. This year's NYE party will include a huge dancefloor, VIP lounge area and open bar.

David Guetta, pioneer of the EDM genre internationalization, will launch his 7th album in 2018. He's the author of memorable songs such as: This One's For You, Love Is Gone, and When Love Takes Over.

Guetta's international boom on the industry came with the "F*ck Me I'm Famous" song on 2000, and two years later he launched his first album "Just a Little More Love". His last record was launched on 2014, the same year he performed in the Dominican Republic for the last time, on this occasion in Punta Cana.

With more than 30 years of artistic trajectory, David Guetta counts with a huge list of stars that have featured with him, such as Rihanna, Madonna, Michael Jackson, Justin Bieber, Akon, Fergie, Usher, Lady Gaga, 50 cent, Nicki Minaj, and others.
